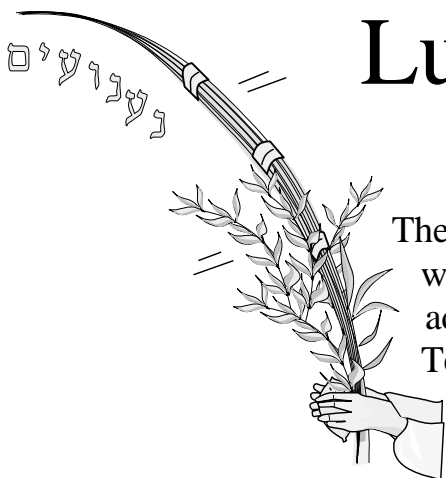

Lulav and Etrog Order Form

Due by 12:00 p.m. Friday, September 14, 2018



The tradition of the Lulav and Etrog on Sukkot can be a ceremony of great wonderment to children, as well as a source of profound meaning to adults. It provides a distinct echo of ancient ceremonies conducted in the Temple in Jerusalem and reflects our thanks to God for the bounty of the world.

We say the blessing over the Lulav and Etrog on each morning of Sukkot (except for Shabbat) beginning on Monday, September 24 and continuing through Sunday, September 30. During Sukkot, the lulav and etrog are used during the Hallel service and later during the special Sukkot festival procession. On the morning of Monday, September 24 and Tuesday, September 25 be sure to bring your lulav and etrog set to Beth Israel, or use one of the synagogue sets, to wave during the Hallel service, and later to carry around in the Lulav and Etrog procession.

Return this form to the synagogue office by 12:00 p.m., Friday, September 14 with full payment to order your Lulav and Etrog set(s). Directions regarding their use and the appropriate blessings are provided with each set. The cost is \$36.00. The Lulav and Etrog will be ready for pickup on Sunday, September 23 from 10:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Pre-purchased sets may also be picked up in the synagogue foyer during the service on September 24 and 25 in the morning and during office hours during the rest of the week. *(The entire cost of the set goes to the vendor. This is not a fundraiser. We encourage anyone who purchases a set to be sure to pick it up. You'll be glad you did – it's an enjoyable mitzvah to do.)*
