## High Holiday Youth and Childcare Programming



**Childcare** (ages 1 - 5 years old): storytime, lots of toys fun during Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur daytime services.

**Parent/Child Room** - Available for parents with children who need a break from services. Toys, books and snacks will be available.

**Elementary School** (K - 5th Grade) are invited to a program on both days of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Activities, tefillah (prayer), stories, snack and more.

**Middle School** (6th - 8th Grade): Participate in a variety of activities on the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.

**High School** students (9th - 12th Grade): Meet on Kol Nidre outside the sanctuary, and hear the chanting of the Kol Nidre prayer. Then proceed downstairs in the main building.
