I will do my best to promote *shalom* and *kavod*
so that BIRS is a safe, peaceful and respectful learning environment.

I will contribute to BIRS's positive learning environment by observing the following *mitzvot*:

- ***Bitachon***, safety – I will act in ways to ensure my safety and the safety of others. I will not engage in unsafe behavior including inappropriate or unwanted physical contact; I will not hit, punch, grab, push or be physically aggressive; I will not bully, threaten or intimidate others, including doing such in a “just kidding,” or “we’re just fooling around” manner.
- ***Kavod***, showing respect—I will show respect for others – students, teachers and BIRS staff, school and synagogue property, and the subject matter. I will respect others’ desire to learn and teachers’ desire to teach. I will not intentionally behave in ways that disrupt or disturb others.
- ***Limmud***, learning—I will endeavor to further my learning and help promote the learning of others.
- ***Lo tignov***, do not steal—I will take what does not belong to me; I will honor copyrights, and will not look at or use someone else’s work without permission.
- ***Rachamim***, compassion—I will act with kindness and compassion; I will not exclude others; I will share supplies and resources.
- ***Shalom***, peace —I will act to promote a safe, positive and harmonious learning environment.
- ***Shmirat lashon***, guarding the tongue—I will use appropriate language. I will not insult or belittle myself or others.
- ***Tzniut***, modesty—I will dress appropriately for a synagogue school.
- ***Z’heerut***, carefulness-I will be careful in my actions and my speech.
